Sports Program

Ball Hockey takes place Monday to Thursday at Windsor Stadium for ages 4-7 and 8-12. Ages 4-7 take part from 1:00-2:30pm and ages 8-12 take part from 2:30-4:00pm.

Equipment Needed: Helmet with full-face shield, stick, gloves & sneakers.

Equipment Recommended: Jock; elbow pads; shin pads.

Basketball takes place Monday to Thursday at Exploits Valley Intermediate for ages 4-7 and 8-12. Ages 4-7 take part from 10:30-12:00pm and ages 8-12 take part from 8:45-10:15am.

Equipment Needed: Gym sneakers.

Boot Camp takes place every Friday at Windsor Stadium for ages 4-7 and 8-12. Ages 4-7 take part from 1:00-2:30pm and ages 8-12 take part from 8:45-10:15am.

Equipment Needed: Gym sneakers.

Central Summer Games will be hosted by the Town of Springdale during August. These games encourage SPORTSMANSHIP, DEDICATION, and FAIR PLAY while the children meet and compete with others from different towns.

Softball takes place for kids aged 8-12 on Monday to Thursday at the Main Street Softball Field from 10:30-12:00pm.

Equipment Needed: Glove

T-Ball takes place for kids aged 4-7 on Monday to Thursday at the Main Street Softball Field from 8:45-10:15am.

Equipment Needed: Glove

Tennis takes place for kids aged 4-7 and 8-12 at the Grand Falls-Windsor Tennis Courts on Lincoln Road from Monday to Thursday. 4-7 year olds take part from 2:30-4:00pm and 8-12 year olds take part from 1:00-2:30pm.

Equipment Needed: Tennis racket, however, if necessary we can provide one.

Volleyball takes place for kids aged 4-7 and 8-12 at the Beach Volleyball Courts from Monday to Thursday. 4-7 year olds take part from 1:00-2:30pm and ages 8-12 take part from 2:45-4:15pm.

Equipment Needed: Sun block and water.

Summer Camps



Creative Camp let's kids explore their creative side with activities such as clay modeling, painting and scrapbooking. This camp takes place on Mondays and Tuesdays, however, each child is only allowed to go ONE day per week and this day must be chosen upon registering. Ages 4-7 participate from 9:30-11:30am and ages 8-12 participate from 1:30-3:30pm at the Youth Center on Bond Street. There is a maximum of 20 participants per class.

The **Integration Program** is designed to integrate the physically and mentally challenged into our summer program, providing them with the opportunity to interact and participate with non-physically challenged children in both the sporting and playground programs. Strong Kids is designed to help kids build life skills so they can develop as they get older. These skills will include, cooking, computer and self defense classes. Strong Kids takes place on Thursday's at a specified location (received upon registration) for ages 4-7 and 8-12. Ages 4-7 take part from 10:00-11:30am and ages 8-12 take part from 2:00-3:00pm.

Summer Camp let's kids celebrate different events every Wednesday at the Youth Center on Bond Street. These events include, Halloween Day, Carnival Day and Olympics Day. Ages 4-7 take part from 9:30-11:00am and ages 8-12 take part from 2:00-3:30pm.

T.G.I.F. helps everyone say "Thank God It's Friday" and it will be celebrated with different activities each week. Activities include bowling, swimming and mini golfing. This program takes place every Friday at different locations (received upon registering) for ages 4-7 from 10:00-11:30am and for ages 8-12 from 2:00-3:30pm.
