

## **Town of Grand Falls-Windsor**

### **Installation of Solid Fuel Burning Appliances**

Pursuant to the authority conferred by Section 414 of the Municipalities Act, the Town of Grand Falls-Windsor has made the following Installation of Solid Fuel Burning Appliances Regulations.

### **Installation of Solid Fuel Burning Appliances**

1. **Interpretations:** In these regulations, unless the context otherwise requires:
  - (a) "Act" means the Municipalities Act.
  - (b) "Town" means the Town of Grand Falls-Windsor as defined in the Order-In-Council dated the 1st day of January, 1992, A.D., and continued as a Town under the said Act.
  - (c) "Solid Fuel Burning Appliance" means a device that converts solid fuel into energy and includes all components, controls, wiring, and piping required to be part of the device, for the purpose of this regulation, shall include furnaces, boilers, stoves, ranges, space heaters, factory-built fireplaces and service water heaters.
2. These regulations shall supplement Canadian Standards Association, installation code for Solid Fuel Burning Appliances and Equipment, B365, current edition, and any other code or standard as adopted by the town, governing the installation of solid fuel burning appliance.
3. Any person installing a solid fuel burning appliance shall obtain a permit from the Town permitting such installation.
4. An inspection of the installation by the Town Fire Department Inspector or the Fire chief or their duly appointed designate shall be conducted prior to the operation of any newly installed solid fuel burning appliance.
5. Said permit shall serve as a building permit for the installation of factory-built chimneys when installed in conjunction with a solid fuel burning appliance.
6. The construction of a site-built chimney shall require a Building Permit from the Town.
7. Any renovation or upgrading to solid fuel burning appliances shall conform to the requirements of this regulation.
8. In accordance with Section 420 of the Act, every person who fails to comply with the provisions of these regulations is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding \$1,000.00 or in default, to a period of

imprisonment not exceeding ninety (90) days or to both such fine and period of imprisonment.

9. The Town of Grand Falls-Windsor installation of Solid Fuel Burning Appliances Regulations dated 1st day of January, 1991, A.D., are hereby repealed.
